When the Standard Solution is just "Not Acceptable"

Glasgow Parish Hall has now become a conference centre. However, one problem was the amount of light coming through the 35 feet Diameter 15 feet height dome.

Several blind companies were invited to tender. Most came up with the standard solution – run the blinds across the base. This was not acceptable to Glasgow City Council.

A different approach was suggested by Mike Falla of Incorporated Blind Systems Ltd, individual blinds in each of the twelve curved windows. An elegant innovative solution but who could make it work? SHY could with motorised blackout blinds at each window, tensioned and fed around relief rollers all acting simultaneously.

The solution so impressed the operators of the Trafford Centre, Manchester that they now have a similar solution to their dome and their's is 150 feet in diameter.
